LOCATION:

All classes take place in the gym at Queen Elizabeth Elementary School, on Saunders Dr, Kensington. Please use the gym entrance which is located at the very far end of the parking lot.

ATTIRE:

Dancers should be dressed in body suit with leotards and/or knee socks. Highland dancing shoes (gillies), or for the short term, black gymnastic slippers should be worn. Hair should be in a pony tail/pulled back neatly off the face. Adult students should wear comfortable, body fitting exercise clothing.

FEES:

Annual fees have been calculated to include allowances for cancellations whether due to school closures or any other reasons. There will be no make-up classes provided.

REFUNDS:

Refunds will be given with 1 full calendar month's notice. For example, if notice is given Feb. 15th then February as well as March cheques will be retained, and April cheques and onward will be returned. Should notice be given during one of the 8 week sessions, no refunds will be given.

CANCELLATIONS:

During the winter, please listen and watch local news websites for school closure announcements. If QEES is closed for the day, closed early, or closed for after school activities due to storm or other reason, all dance classes are cancelled. Dance students will be notified by email of cancellations for any other reasons and I will also try to post such cancellations on our website. If you are still unsure if classes are cancelled, you may call my cell at 902-888-1363 as cancellations will be on voice mail.

COMPETITION INSTRUCTOR FEE:

In the 2009 - 2010 dance year, I will attend all PEI competitions plus one off-Island competition (Sackville, NB) free of charge. Should you wish me, as your dancer's instructor, to attend competitions with you and your dancer outside of those listed above a fee of \$20/hr, as well as \$0.45/km mileage will be charged. These fees can also be divided among a group of dancers should multiple requests be made for instructor attendance. Requests should be made well in advance. Instructor attendance is based on availability.
